<u>HIGHLIGHTS</u>

1. General information

The Automation Business Unit of Leonardo S.p.a., incorporated in Italy as a joint stock company, (hereinafter "LEONARDO") intends to issue a call for tender in the frame of the "Melbourne Orlando International Airport - MLB Baggage Handling System Project" (the "Project").

The scope of Project is the Electrical and Mechanical Installation of the Baggage Handling Systems ("BHS") of the Melbourne Orlando International Airport, which includes installation of all the necessary systems and components (including sorter, conveyors, chutes, etc.).

2. Expression of Interest (EoI)

No later than the deadline of this Call for Tender, companies interested in being invited to the Tender are requested to:

register themselves in the ARIBA DISCOVERY platform (https://service.ariba.com/Discovery.aw/125002028/aw?awh=r&awssk=4lnnwl5Q) and proceed, after obtaining their credentials, with the provision of the required data.

Companies that are already registered in the above platform, are in any case requested to confirm and update the previously entered data and information;

No Eol can be submitted and thus will be accepted after the expiry of this Call for Tender.

LEONARDO reserves the right to request further documentation to the suppliers, after their Eol notification.

3. Clarifications

LEONARDO will submit any necessary information relevant to the Tender and its management only to those companies that, following the submission of their EOI – complete with all the required documents as per the above par. 2 – will be invited to participate in Tender.

LEONARDO has the obligation neither to invite to the Tender any companies having submitted their Eol nor to motivate its decision.

This Call for Tender is in no way binding on either LEONARDO or the companies submitting their EOI.

LEONARDO, at its sole discretion, reserves the right not to award the Tender, to award only part of it, to restart its procedure and/or to make any changes to this Call for Tender it will deem necessary.

Finally, it should be noted that in order to sign the contract, the company that will be awarded the Tender must have necessarily and successfully completed the process to become a qualified supplier of LEONARDO.

4. How to be a Leonardo supplier

The suppliers admitted to participate in the selection and awarding procedures of contracts for the supply of goods, services and technical-industrial services must be **pre-qualified**. Subsequently, to receive a purchase order, the supplier must be **qualified**.

The start of the pre-qualification process is subject to the self-nomination of the Supplier on the Portal. Upon completion of entering the required data, during the registration phase on the Portal, the Supplier assumes the status of Potential Supplier and the Buyer can request the start of the pre-qualification process.



4.1 Pre-Qualification

Pre-qualification consists in carrying out checks finalized at understanding that potential suppliers with the following requirements:

- Ethical-legal
- Relating to economic-financial capacity and reliability

The suppliers with annual turnover generated by orders from LEONARDO Group companies **exceeding**70% of the total turnover cannot be pre-qualified

4.2 Qualification

The qualification consists in carrying out checks finalized at verifying that potential suppliers possess the specific technical-professional requirements required by Automation's business and product peculiarities:

- Technical-organizational
- · Health & Safety
- Environmental management
- Information security
- Protection of intellectual property

5. Processing of personal data

Pursuant to Legislative Decree 196/2003 and EU Reg. 679/2016 (hereinafter jointly referred to as the '**Privacy Law'**), we inform you that the personal data that a company will provide in the context of this Tender will be processed by LEONARDO as Data Controller (pursuant to the Privacy Law), for the purposes related to the Tender management process, to the possible subsequent awarding and to the relevant stipulation of the contract.

6. Regulations as per Legislative Decree 231/2001 and Anti-corruption Law
