## The role of Finmeccanica in the FREMM program

Finmeccanica participates in the FREMM program through its companies Selex ES, OTO Melara, WASS and MBDA.

Selex ES is in charge of supplying and integrating the entire Combat Management System, including radar sensors, communications, electro-optical and navigation systems.

OTO Melara is responsible for equipping the new naval units with 127 Vulcano naval gun systems complete with automatic warehouses for the management of ammunition, 76/62mm Strales gun systems, 25mm KBA turrets and decoy launchers AWDLS, while WASS will supply the Mine Avoidance Sonar and torpedo handling systems.

MBDA Italia will provide the SAAM ESD extended anti air warfare system for Aster 15 and Aster 30 missiles, as well as the Teseo MK2/A anti-ship system based on Teseo missiles.

**Finmeccanica** is Italy's leading manufacturer in the high technology sector and ranks among the top ten global players in Aerospace, Defence and Security.
